Incorporating EFT Level 2 Practitioner Certification

This Advanced course applies Emotional Freedom Technique for complex mental health problems characterised by obsessive and compulsive behaviour. The focus is on eating disorders such as binge eating, anorexia and bulimia plus other substance abuse disorders.

EFT, Eating Disorders and Addictions

Eating disorders and addictions are complex conditions noted for their serious effects on both sufferers and the people who care for them. Treatment must focus on the symptoms and the underlying emotional dynamics which give rise to them. We as therapists therefore find ourselves helping people to manage overwhelming drives to perform harmful behaviours as well as to undo the effects of perfectionism, trauma and poor emotional resilience.

This course is suitable for any health professional with an existing EFT Level 1 certification. If you encounter eating disorders and addictions in your work we will teach you Advanced EFT skills - including working remotely with EFT - which will help you work safely, pleasantly and effectively with your clients.

You Will Learn

- How to use a range of approaches to regulate the level of emotional intensity in the session.
- To assist the client identify and negotiate the internal conflicts and limiting beliefs associated with their eating and addictive behaviours.
- To carry out an assessment of suitability for EFT telephone treatment and conduct a session over the phone.
- Use of at least two approaches for treatment of traumatic memories.
- Use of EFT for relieving physical pain and other physical symptoms.
- How to conduct an introductory session of EFT with a group.
- How to use creative EFT language approaches such as metaphor, humour, time shifts and reframes.

You will be able to generalise these skills to other psychological contexts. EFT is useful for addiction work, mood disorders, phobias, OCD and trauma.

Course Syllabus

- Advanced EFT approaches for addictions and eating disorders including use of metaphor and working with personality “parts”.
- Safety for you and your client. Regulating distress in and outside the session.
- How to deal with dissociation.
- EFT for trauma and PTSD using the Movie Technique, the Story Technique, the Letter Technique, Tearless Trauma Technique.
- Using EFT on the telephone, with groups, with children and young people.
- EFT for pain and physical issues.
- EFT for negative and limiting beliefs underlying eating problems and addictions.
- Additional acupressure points.
- Advanced use of language, using humour, reframing and choices with EFT.
- Advanced troubleshooting.
- Integrating EFT into your practice.

Assessment and Certification

Please be mindful that EFT courses have a great deal of experiential content. The trainer will undertake continuous assessment of delegates during the course and afterwards you will be required to complete a practical assignment with three satisfactory case studies including one on yourself. This confers the Practitioner Certificate in Emotional Freedom Techniques and eligibility for full membership of AAMET (The Association for Advancement of Meridian Energy Techniques).
